ORDER

**WHEREAS**, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

**2. AND WHEREAS**, the institution, **Alagappa University College of Education, Karaikudi-630003, Pasumpon Mathuramalingam District, Tamilnadu** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in **B.Ed** which require additional facilities.

**3. AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have one unit of 50 students subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I. The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- II. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
- III. The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017

**4. NOW THEREFORE**, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Alagappa University College of Education, Karaikudi-630003, Pasumpon Mathuramalingam District, Tamilnadu** for conducting **B.Ed** programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students each for two basic units from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015

**5.** Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

**6.** The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a chartered Accountant.

- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made of issued there under , the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the regional committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

**WHEREAS**, recognition u/s 15 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Alagappa University, Department of Education, Karaikudi, Tamilnadu-630003** vide order no. F.TN/M.Ed./SRO/NCTE//2005-2006/1401 dt. 07.06.2005 for conducting **M.Ed.** course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-06 with an annual intake of 25 students.

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

The National Council for Teacher Education is a Statutory Body that came into existence in pursuance of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (No. 73 of 1993) on 17<sup>th</sup> August 1995 to achieve planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system throughout the country, the regulation and proper maintenance of Norms and Standards in the teacher education system and for matters connected therewith.

2. As per the provisions of the NCTE Act, 1993 and NCTE Regulations 2014, as amended from time to time, Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) is required to be submitted annually by the existing Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs). Accordingly, NCTE had issued a Public Notice on 22.09.2019 directing all TEIs running NCTE recognised Teacher Education Courses to file PAR for academic session 2018-19. The last date for submission of PAR was 31.12.2019, which was later on extended till 20.01.2020 (Mid night).

3. Aggrieved with the said Public Notice, a number of TEIs approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 11304/2019 and obtained stay thereon. Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 11304/2019 pronounced the Judgment on 27.5.2021 upholding the decision of NCTE requiring the TEIs to file PAR. In view of decision of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, PAR was required to be mandatorily submitted by all TEIs for the academic session 2020-2021. Timeline to submit PAR was from 29.09.2021 to 28.01.2022 (mid night) which was later on extended till 15.03.2022.

4. The Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, *vide* its Order dated 25 February 2022, while upholding the decision of the Single Bench extended the date of filing of PAR to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2022.


5. Thereafter, the Hon'ble Supreme Court, *vide* its Order dated 01.04.2022 in SLP No. 5479/2022, decided that the TEIs would have to file PAR for the academic session 2020-21 by 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2022.

6. The matter was placed before the General Body of the Council in its 54<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 and the Council *inter-alia* decided that with regard to the TEIs which have not filed PAR in compliance with Hon'ble Supreme Court's deadline of 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2022, the academic session 2022-23 shall be declared as a zero academic year for fresh intake.

7. In view of the decision taken by the General Body of the Council, appropriate authorities/affiliating bodies concerned are hereby requested to take necessary action accordingly in

respect of the TEIs under their jurisdiction which have not filed PAR by 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2022, for academic session 2020-21, in compliance

with the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court. A State-wise list of the institutions which have filed PAR for the academic session 2020-21 is attached herewith.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to **Alagappa University College of Physical Education, Karaikudi - 623004, Tamilnadu** for **M.P.Ed. Course** of two years duration for the academic session **2000-2001** only with an annual intake of **52**, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The institution shall appoint within a period of one year **two** additional teaching staff possessing the academic qualifications as laid down in the NCTE norms, in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government as the case may be
2. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the norms within a period of two years of this order
3. The institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as per the NCTE norms.
4. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be.
5. Tuition fee and other fees will be charged from the students as per the norms of the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be till such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.
6. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the norms and standards for the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body as the case may be.
7. Teaching days including practice teaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.
8. The institution, if unaided, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms

8. The Institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

If **Alagappa University College of Physical Education, Karaikudi - 623004, Tamilnadu** contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

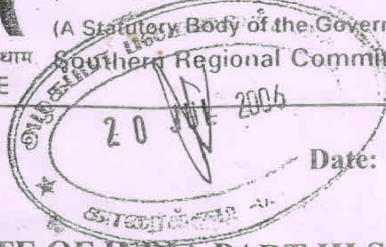

In terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Alagappa University College of Physical Education, Karaikudi-623004, Tamilnadu** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for C.P.Ed course of two years duration from the academic session 2005-06.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- b. The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
- c. The institution has selected the **Principal** and **five** teachers for the said course, which is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Alagappa University College of Physical Education, Karaikudi-623004, Tamilnadu** for C.P.Ed course of **two years duration** from the academic session **2006-07** with an annual intake of **50** students, subject to fulfillment of the following:

- a. The institution will ensure that **six** exclusive faculty members (**Principal and five teachers**) duly approved by the DTERT are in position for an intake of **50** students and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of admissions for the course. The faculty list is to be approved by the Director, DTERT, Chennai.
- b. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
- c. FDR for endowment fund should be converted in the joint name of the Regional Director, SRC-NCTE and the management represented if it is not already done.
- d. The institution should move to their own building within three years from the date of recognition of teacher training institute.




5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
