ALAGAPPA UNIVERSITY

Alagappa University, established by the Government of Tamil Nadu under an Act of the State Legislature in 1985, and located on a sprawling expanse of about 436 acres in the business town of Karaikudi in Sivagangai District of Tamil Nadu, is ideally suited for higher education. The campus is accessible from Tiruchirappalli and Madurai in about two hours by surface transport.

This seat of Higher Education has emerged from the galaxy of institutions initially founded at Karaikudi during 1950's by the munificent and multifaceted personality, **PadmaBhushan Dr.RM. Alagappa Chettiar** and is groomed to prominence as yet another academic constellation in Tamil Nadu. As a member of the Commonwealth Universities and Association of Indian Universities, Alagappa University has rewarding relations with other national and international **academic/ research/ industrial institutions** that promise a spectacular future to the learners.

The University's motto is **“Excellence in Action”** and it is determined to keep before the vision of excellence in all spheres of education. To achieve this, the University continually upgrades its programs of studies and research and is a fore-runner in introducing many frontier level programs of learning as well.

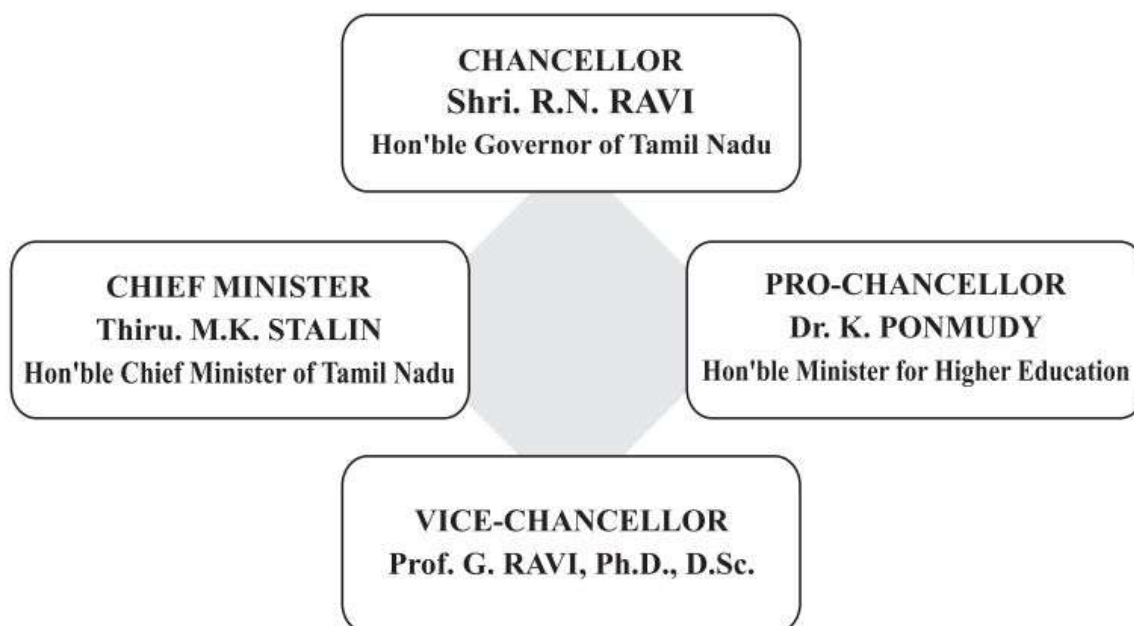

Alagappa University has been recognised under Section 2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act. It has been awarded with A+ Grade by NAAC (CGPA:3.64 out of 4.00) in the Third Cycle of assessment and also the first State University that obtained the A+ status in the State of Tamil Nadu. The University has been classified under Category-I status on account of its NAAC score. Alagappa University is placed 47th Ranking in University Category, 76th Ranking in Overall Category, 17th Rank in State Public Universities Category under National Institutional Ranking Frame work (NIRF) 2024 declared by the Ministry of Education (MoE), New Delhi. Under QS World Ranking 2024, Alagappa University is placed in 32nd position in QS India Ranking, 59th position in QS Southern Asia Ranking and the bandwidth of 271-280 in QS Asia University Ranking. Under Times Higher Education ranking (THE), Alagappa University has secured 111th position in THE – ASIA (2023) ranking and placed in the 101-150 bandwidth in the World Young University Ranking. Further, Alagappa University has shown remarkable improvement in Times Higher Education (THE) - World University ranking (2024) and placed in the 601-800 bandwidth. For the subject category (Physical & Life Sciences), Alagappa University is placed in the 501-600 bandwidth. Recognizing the extension activities, Mahatma Gandhi National council for Rural Education (MGNCRE), New Delhi, awarded the Alagappa University as “**One District One Green Champion**” and a Mentor Institution for Mainstreaming Swachhta Action Plan and Jal Shakthi Abhyan in rural areas through community engagements.

The University has five UGC-SAP (Special Assistance Programme) and six DST-FIST (Fund for improvement of Science and Technology) supported Departments. During the past five years, the University generated more than Rs. 20 crore from DST-PURSE, DST-FIST, UGC-SAP and DBT – BIC & NNP. A sum of Rs.20 crore from MHRD - RUSA Phase 1.0 has been received for creation and upgradation of infrastructure facilities and Rs.100 crore for improvement of Teaching, Learning and Research facilities under RUSA Phase 2.0. Nine International MoUs and 48 National MoUs were signed with international Universities and Institutes for Academic, Research, Industrial, faculty and students exchange programmes. The University has made a milestone through 11,269 publications with h-index 118 and the faculty members have filed 59 patents from their research work and 37 Patents were published / granted. The University has implemented digitalization through Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) facilities in the Central Library and Automation of Examination process. Alagappa University is adopting the Cashless transaction and Paperless communication in all administrative and academic endeavors apart from creating awareness to the public about Digital India. The University has established Community Radio (FM 90.8 MHz) for societal development.
